7. [NC] Did you D/ ever see a Bear D/ combing his hair

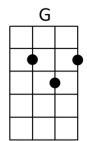
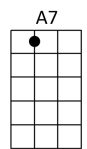
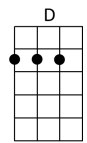
