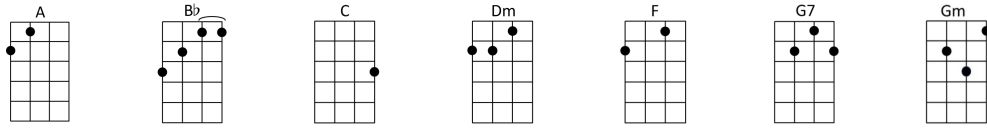


# THE STAR SPANGLED BANNER
