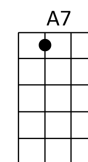
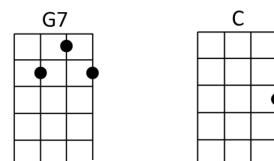
Bridge

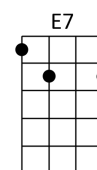
