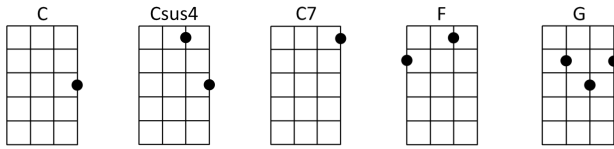


LITTLE DRUMMER BOY
