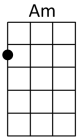

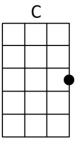

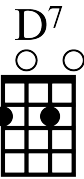
V1 The [G] garment of life, be it [Am] tattered and torn

The [Em] light that shines for [Am] all to see



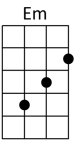

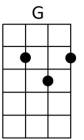
