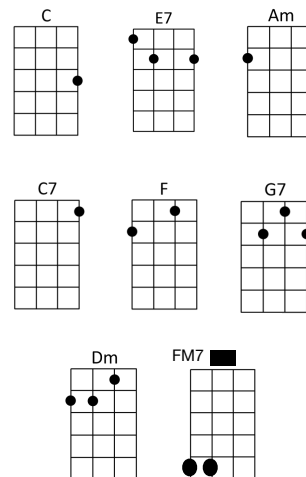


THERE'S A KIND OF HUSH
